Questions to answer about web hosting

Create an html document that answers the following questions. Use the following html elements properly:

*<h1>, <h2>, <p>, , , , <div>, *change text-family, color, and size, *change background color, and add an image.*

1. Up Time and load time (see consumer rankings for information)
2. Do I have ftp privileges so I can update my site?
(Most services offer this but some sites offering free hosting don't offer this feature)
3. What are the storage costs? And how much storage do I need?
4. Do I get a traffic report on user statistics?
5. What are the extra costs involved for getting a domain name? Is the domain name registered in my name?
6. Is there a limit on bandwidth or data transfer?
7. What kinds of support do they offer? Are there tutorials?
8. Can I get a domain name? How much is it?

9. Is there an easy way to install WordPress?

10. Talk with customer service and find out one thing you didn't know about that is offered and be ready to explain what that is.
