

Brainstorming Infographics

Today, we are going to start imagining what sort of visual narrative you'll create for your niche-o-graphic. Elizabeth is here to help you brainstorm, find useful statistics, and find information on topics regarding your niche-o-graphic. Create a document that chunks, queues, and filters information like below!

Brainstorm – 5 minutes

First, get into a partnership and discuss your niches. Let's each make a list of three topics or bits of information or keywords that might be important for considering in our niche.

Student 1 – Topic 1, Topic 2, Topic 3

Student 2 – Topic 1, Topic 2, Topic 3

Statistics – 15 minutes

Select *one* of the niche topic ideas and start to research it. Help each other out. Research that niche together and use the resources the librarian has provided and find three important visualizations (charts/graphs) or statistics that relate to the niche topics you listed in your brainstorm. List the information below, provide a link, and in a sentence say how it connects to the niche. **CHUNK, QUEUE, and FILTER** the info.
